

As you watch the rolling boulder sequence from Raiders of the Lost Ark (1981), the training sequence from The Matrix (2000) or another sequence your teacher has chosen, try to identify the rhythm the editor established in making cuts.

Tap a pencil each time there is a cut. (This will be easier to do if you watch the scene a second time with the sound off.) For example, if all the shots are about the same length, a steady metrical beat results. Shortening each shot in a sequence results in an accelerating rhythm.
