

MUSIC VIDEO

<u>Objective</u>: Students will create a unique music video using either an original or commercial piece of music. Songs and videos should deal with a societal issue in positive manner. Your video should interpret the musical piece you have chosen.

Product:

- 1. All music must be screened and approved by the teacher. This requires a comprehensive lyric sheet (1st step) and treatment.
- 2. All music videos must be scripted and storyboarded in detail. The shot list should match to the lyric sheet and the treatment.
- 3. All music videos will meet the following conditions:
 - a. No obscene/profane lyrics.
 - b. No use or showing of drugs, alcohol, weapons, or nudity.
 - c. No explicitly or implicitly sexual materials.
- 4. Each video must meet specific criteria in order to be acceptable. Unacceptable videos must be re-submitted for credit.

Criteria:

- 1. $1\frac{1}{2}$ 4 minutes in length
- 2. Video adequately matches audio (pictures illustrate lyrics)
- 3. Video is completed with care and demonstrates attention to detail and demonstrates mastery of camera and/or editing techniques.
- 4. Full credits for all aspects of the video
- 5. Follow guidelines from all handouts
- 6. Videos will be graded with the "Music Video Grading Rubric"
